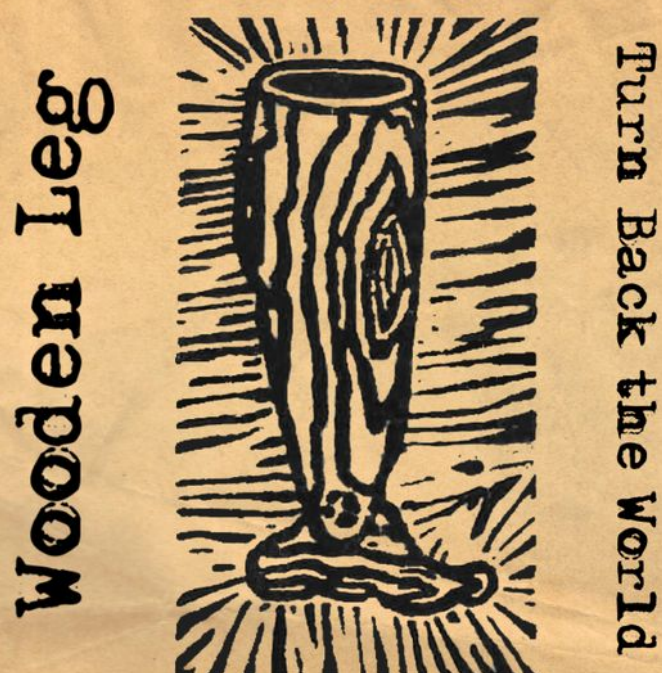

Wooden Leg's "Turn Back the World", the band's first album in 20 years, is the happy result of a late-2018 Boston show which was, unbeknownst to the band, recorded by the house sound engineer. The result is this live recording.

The band lineup for this album features **Jimmy Ryan** (Blood Oranges, Hayride, Mary Gauthier, Laura Cantrell, and Catie Curtis) playing mandolin and singing, **Duke Levine** (Peter Wolf, J. Geils Band, Dennis Brennan Band, Mary Chapin Carpenter) on electric guitar, **Joe Kessler** on fiddle and harmonies (Boiled in Led, Klezwoods, Sam Reid and the Riot Act), **Mickey Bones** on drums (Hot Tamales Brass Band, Boston Red Sox), and bassist **Brian Dunton** (Helium, Dumptruck).

This is an album for a very late Saturday night, a wild wedding, or for driving around too fast.
