

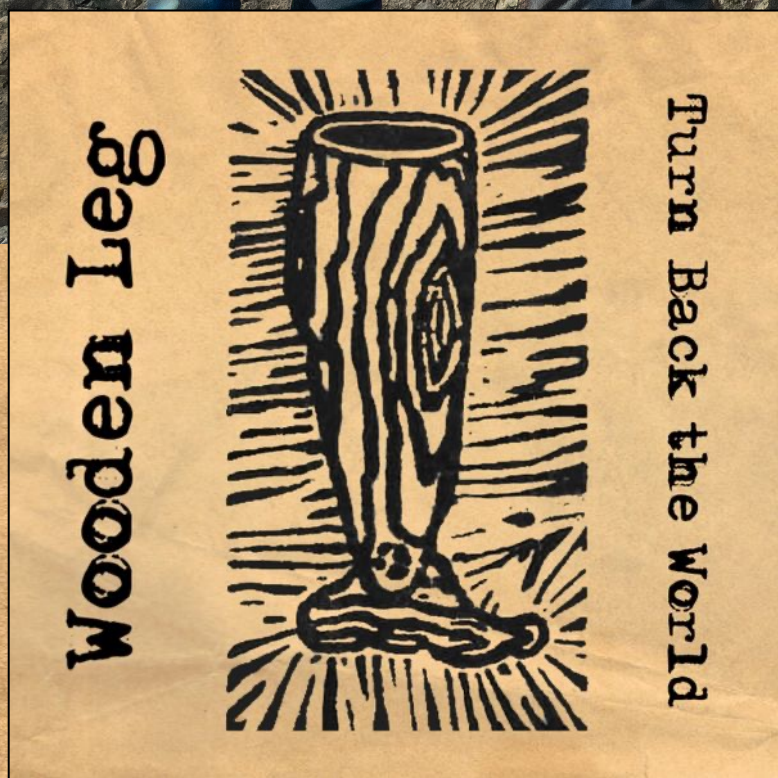
Wooden Leg

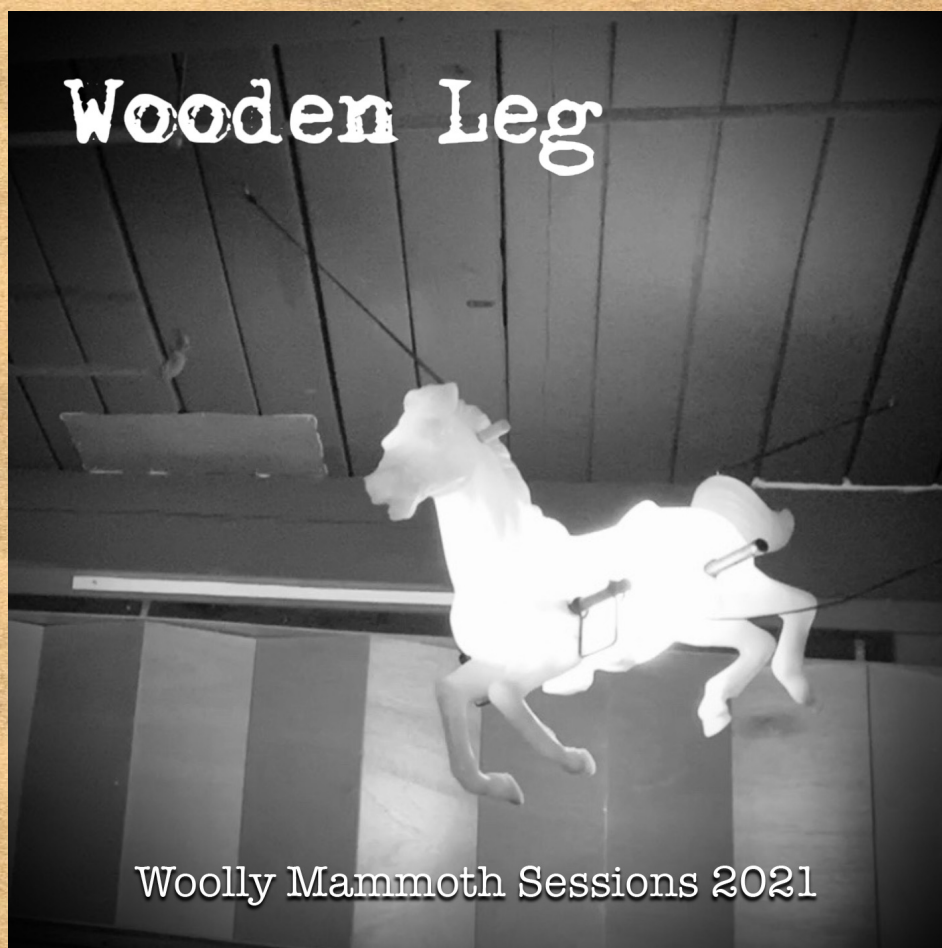
